

Want to learn what it takes to achieve net-zero?

Net-Zero Energy Building Design

This two day training will focus on design and construction details to achieve net-zero energy use in new buildings. Join **Ian Shapiro** founder of Taitem Engineering (Ithaca, NY) and co-author of the book *Green Building Illustrated* (Wiley, 2014) and **Liz Walker**, co-founder of EcoVillage at Ithaca, and Executive Director of its educational arm, Learn@EcoVillage as they address fundamentals and strategies for zero-energy design. Ecovillage and cohousing concepts will be covered as well as site visits to homes and community buildings at EcoVillage's three cohousing neighborhoods, emphasizing different green building approaches, styles, and details, culminating in the newest neighborhood called TREE, the largest Passivhaus development in North America. **This course will provide 14 AIA learning units.**
